

Strengthening vocational baccalaureate programmes (BTH) at secondary schools (Chiquitania region)

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Short Project Description

The aim of the project "**Fortalecimiento del Bachillerato Técnico Humanístico en la Chiquitania - FBTH**" is to train secondary school students with an indigenous or farming background at three different vocational training centers.

The project aims to develop the technical and vocational skills of young secondary school students in order to increase their chances of finding a job or to enable them to run their own businesses and thus improve their income and quality of life.

The project is based in three municipalities of Santa Cruz: San Julián, Concepción and San Ignacio de Velasco. In all three municipalities, the aim is to improve the efficiency of the centers' management and to promote the local economy by improving vocational training in the region. To ensure sustainability, the project is being implemented in collaboration with the autonomous municipal administration, the district directorates and the schools' parents' councils.

Main Project Goals

- 3 Educational Units implement improvement plans to strengthen educational institutional management
- 49 teachers are trained in their technical specializations as well as in cross-cutting topics.
- 12 Technical careers with equipment and educational resources; considering technological progress, occupational health and safety.
- 600 students certified as Humanistic Technical Baccalaureate (BTH) at the intermediate technical level, with technical, productive and labor skills.
